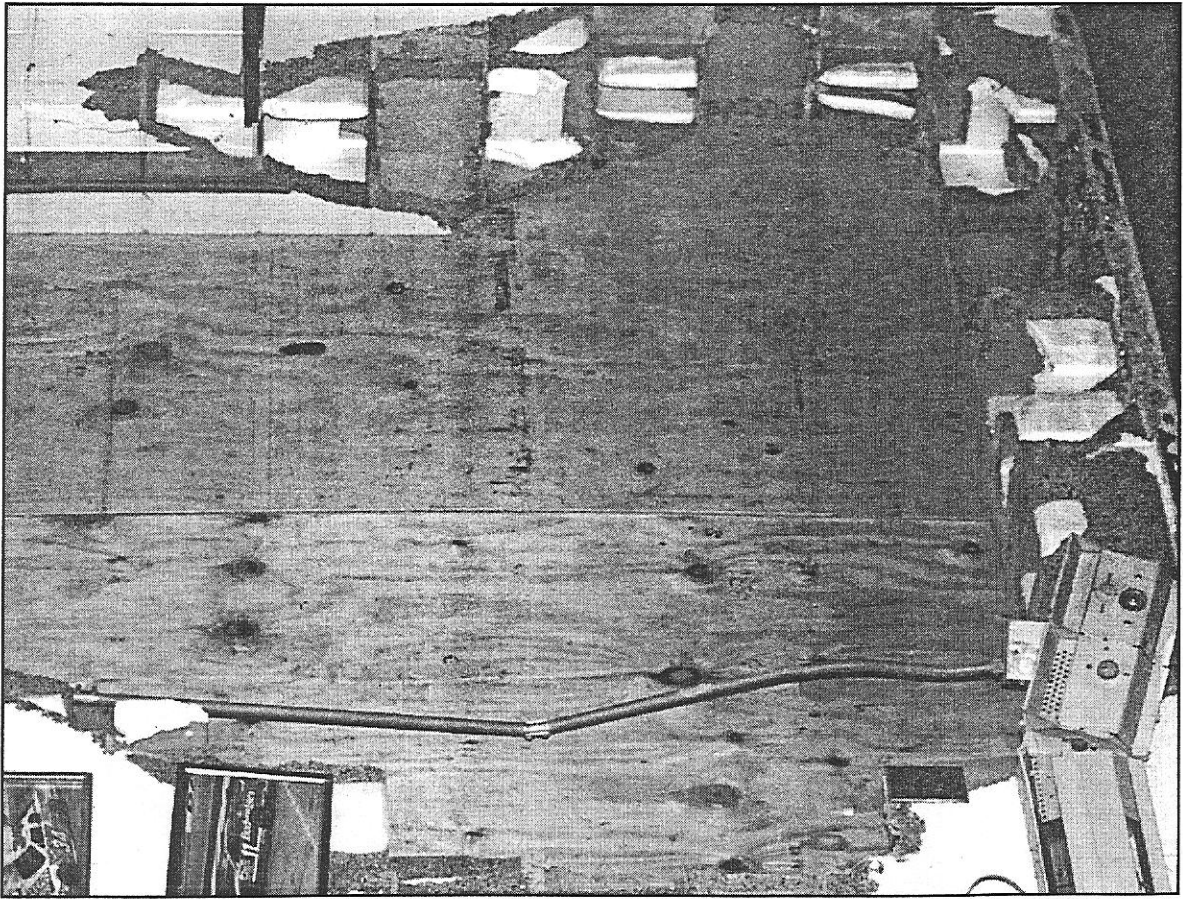

Monson Fire Department Chief Elmer 'Bud' Harris was surprised to see his office a bit altered Saturday morning, as a 21-year-old man drove his 1989 Ford pickup truck through the wall of Harris' office at 1:23 a.m. Peter J. Ross of 101 Wales Road was neither injured nor cited with a violation, according to Monson Police Chief Joseph Rebellio. Ross told police that he confused the accelerator pedal for the brake and struck the wall of the Monson Fire Station. In addition to the large hole, infrastructural work to the 21-year-old building may be needed due to the impact of the crash, said Harris.
